

How to read the cover of a pesticide label!

Brand name of the pesticide. Given by the company that sells the product.

Type of product, indicating that the product is a herbicide with 3 active ingredients

Signal word, indicates the relative acute toxicity of the product to humans.

Active ingredients, showing the list of chemicals that are responsible for causing the damage to the plant.

Other ingredients, include everything else within the jug that are needed to make the product useable.

FIRST AID If in eyes: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice. If swallowed: Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by the poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. If on skin or on clothing: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15 - 20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice. If inhaled: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth if possible. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor or going for treatment. You may also contact 1-877-800-5556 for emergency medical treatment advice.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage.

Signal Word Meanings

Danger-Poison: highly toxic by any route of entry

Danger: highly toxic by at least 1 route of entry

Warning: moderately toxic

Caution: slightly toxic

First Aid Info, explains the steps to take when exposed in different situations to this product.

Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) registration number, assigned to the product once it has been evaluated and approved by the EPA.

Container size, indicates the total contents.

Pesticide labels contain all the essential information for safe, effective, and legal use, including directions, precautions, and restrictions. Using a pesticide in any way not listed on the label is a violation of federal law.
